The primary purpose of the Chowan Christian Service Association shall be to provide scholarship assistance to worthy and needy students preparing for full-time Christian vocational ministry at Chowan University. This will be accomplished by soliciting funds through gifts, bequests and so forth. In fulfilling this purpose the Association shall provide personal support to ministerial students. This will be accomplished by befriending the students, encouraging the students in their educational and spiritual pursuits, and helping the students find places of service in area churches. The secondary purpose of the Association shall be to provide scholarship assistance for mission experiences undertaken by full-time Chowan students and sponsored by the University. By hands-on experiences in mission endeavors students will be able to clarify God's plans for their lives.

- a. Scholarship recipients must be full-time students pursuing Bachelor's Degrees and preparing for full-time Christian vocational ministry. Full-time students are students who register for twelve or more semester hours of academic work each semester.
- b. Recipients must maintain an overall 2.5 grade point average in their studies or risk nonrenewal of their scholarships.
- c. Recipients must be of unquestionable moral character.
- d. Recipients shall be positive proponents of campus Christian life, including participation and leadership in activities such as the Christian Student Union, Gospel Choir, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Christian concerts and lectures and mission experiences.

Recipients shall cooperate and participate in the University's ministerial programs, such as Ministerial Education Day, internships, and/or work for an area church.

Former Students : Any recipient who terminates his/her full-time Christian vocational ministry or preparation for that ministry will be requested to repay the scholarship to the Association following graduation or withdrawal from the university. Following graduation all recipients will be encouraged to become members of the Association and encourage others to do likewise.
