Q: How do I pay my deposit?

Q: May I choose whom my apartment mates will be?

A: Space is based on first come first served. If you and your roommates are eligible at the same time, then you should all show up at the same time, or have one person take all apps and information. If different class status, you may not end up with your desired apartment mate.

Q: May I sign up without apartment mate preferences?

Yes. Sign ups are based on who shows up.

Q: When do I sign up for a private room in Whites Crossing?

A: It depends if you want a private space in and apartment building or a suite building. See the sign up schedule.

Q: If all the private spaces are full what happens?

A: We will contact you via email to make you aware that you are on the waiting list and will be assigned a suite style space or placed on the waiting list. There will be no refunds on additional \$150 deposit paid. The extra \$150 will go towards your student account.

Q: Is my deposit refundable?

A: Deposits are not-refundable as they go towards the balance of your student account for the next semester; however, if you are not returning to Chowan for the Fall 2024 semester you may request a refund on your deposit until May 1. 2024. If you deposited for a private room and a private room is not available, the deposit is not refundable as it goes towards your balance for the fall semester.

Q: I am signing up with a group, may one person from the group submit everyone's paperwork?

A: Yes. Each person must pay deposit and complete the online application process. One person can show up on signup day and signup everyone in the suite if they are eligible.

Q: May I submit my paperwork early?

A: If you are on a scheduled university trip, you can submit your paperwork to Residence Life, prior to your departure and we will place you at your eligible time.

Q: I am not sure if I meet the requirements for Whites Crossing?

A: If you have paid your deposit, completed the housing application, and have not oustanding medical requriements, you meet the requirements.

Q: Where do I go to sign up for housing?

A: Pay your deposit, complete your application, and signup for a space at the time you are eligible for.

Q: May I change my meal plan after I sign up?

A: You will be able to make changes to your meal plan by contacting Residence Life prior to May 8, 2024. After May 8, 2024 contact the Business Office at 252.398.6478.

Q: May I change my room assignment after I sign up?

A: Room changes will be limited to the constraints of spaces available.

Q: I am a male and I want to live in Parker Hall for the Fall 2024 semester.

A: All student are required to sign up in Whites Crossing. Parker is designated for new students and overflow.

Q: How soon will I know my assignment?

A: Once you pick you assignment in the Penny Hall Conference Room you will know your assignment immediately. You will be able to see your assignment in MYCU within 24 hours for the Fall 2024 semester.

Q: Can a male and a female sign up for the same suite or apartment?

A: No.

Q: What do I do if I have a disability?

A: Students that require special housing accommodations, for disabilities, should make such request to Disability Services at (252) 398-6570 or disabilityservices@chowan.edu. To be considered for such accommodations, request must be submitted by May 1 for the Fall Semester and November 1 for the Spring Semester. All request are subject to approval and availability.

Q: How do I see if I am clear with the Business Office?

A: You can check for your Business Office Clearance in your "MYCU" Account

Whites Crossing Apartments:

Living Room:

Love Seat, 2 Lounge Chairs, coffee table, multi-shelf entertainment center & one high-top round table with four stools. This space also contains a closet with shelves for extra storage. (Whites Crossing B will have a larger counter with four stools instead of a round table).

Full Kitchen:

Refrigerator/Freezer with ice maker, garbage disposal, microwave, electric range, spacious cabinets.

Laundry Room:


Equipped with stack washer and dryer. You may also use this space a place to stow a vacuum and broom.

Rathroom:

Separate shower and sink area. Two sinks with storage, large mirror, and lighting. Shower with foot ledge. University provides shower curtain.

Bedroom:

Spacious private bedroom. Includes a full size bed that gives plenty of space for storage and even the ability to slide the included two drawer storage chests underneath. There is a large closet for hanging items and storage above. A standard table desk is provided with a Trey Chair[™]. At first glance Trey's stance is purely a task chair. Yet its sophistication (and fun!) is revealed in three quick steps transforming it from task chair to floor rocker and table/stool, enhancing the unique and alternative study positions of today's student. With Trey, studying at a desk becomes the exception and not the rule with flexibility to read, work on a computer, converse, even watch TV in the comfortable floor rocker and have a table to support a laptop, beverage, or even a friend!



Whites Crossing Suites:

Living Room:

Love Seat, 2 Lounge Chairs, coffee table, multi-shelf entertainment center & one high-top round table with four stools. This space also contains a closet with shelves for extra storage.

Separate shower and sink area. Two sinks with storage, large mirror and lighting. Shower with foot ledge. University provides shower curtain.


Bedroom:

Traditional occupancy bedroom. Includes two twin size beds that allow the residents to bunk their beds or set them up separately. Each resident will have two-two drawer storage chests that can be stacked or placed underneath their adjustable height beds. There are two closets for hanging items and storage above. Each resident is equipped with a standard table desk provided with a T rey Chair™that is exclusively for Whites Crossing residents. At first glance Trey's stance is purely a task chair. Yet its sophistication (and fun!) is revealed in three quick steps transforming it from task chair to floor rocker and table/stool, enhancing the unique and alternative study positions of today's student. With Trey, studying at a desk becomes the exception and not the rule with fle xibility to read, work on a computer, converse, even watch TV in the comfortable floor rocker and have a table to support a laptop, bever age, or even a friend!

Laundry:

A community laundry space is provided on the first level of each suite. Each resident can use their HawksCard to access laun dry with the included \$45 of LaundryBucks each semester. Laundry is made easy at Chowan with quick access to Laundry View which allows students to view when washers and dryer are available and complete. Users may even setup text alerts to be notified when their laundry has completed its cycle.

Whites Crossing Recreation Room and Volleyball Court:

Each Whites Crossing resident is afforded access to these spaces just by virtue of being a resident of the Whites Crossing community.

The recreation room is located on the first floor of Building E. The room boasts of a mini-workout facility which includes; a stationary bike, a treadmill and an elliptical machine. If you just want to blow off some steam with some friends, come play a round of pool on our 8ft. Chowan blue pool table. This space also includes a study area, two 50" inch TV's, restroom, and water fountain.

You may choose to play a volleyball game with your suitemates in the sand volleyball court located on the west side of Building C.

Whites Crossing Multi-Purpose Room:

All Whites Crossing resident have access to the Multi-Purpose room as a space for activities or use the computers to complete your school assignments. See Residence Life to reserce this space for your special event.

Housekeeping:

Whites Crossing residents are required to maintain their living spaces, including restrooms. Large trashcans are available on the first floor for bagged trash. Room inspections will occur on a monthly basis. Housekeeping is only provided in breezeways and common laundry and kitchens areas on the first floor of suite buildings. Students should provide all necessary paper products as well as trash cans for their bedrooms, bathrooms, and kitchens.
